- -Any full-length work of fiction (novel or collection of short stories)
- -Published Oct. 1, 2022 through Dec. 31, 2023
- -Galleys for 2023 publication date will also be accepted
- -The writer must be an African-American U.S. citizen
- -Self-published books will not be accepted
- -Emailed entries will not be accepted

The award, initiated by donors of the Baton Rouge Area Foundation to honor Mr. Gaines, is designed to inspire and recognize rising African-American writers of excellence as they work to achieve the literary heights for which Ernest J. Gaines is known.
